President Eburne called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m.

(4) COMMITTEE REPORTS

EXECUTIVE

President Eburne advised that he and the Executive Director met with the Anonymous Donor to review the Amendment Agreement which replaces in its entirety the terms and conditions set out in the "Original Grant Agreement". The remaining term ends March 31, 2018.

Directors agreed that the Executive Director renegotiate proposed Grant Fund percentage increases to the Donor.

President Eburne advised that the Strategic Planning review sessions were cancelled due to membership unavailability and will be rescheduled for early September.

FINANCIAL

Director Lo reviewed the quarterly report from the Vancouver Foundation.

Director Lo has agreed to represent the Foundation at Columbia Basin Trust monthly meetings.

GOVERNANCE

A motion to expand the boundaries of the Cranbrook and District Community Foundation will be introduced at the Annual General Meeting.

Former Director Crane is preparing an amended policy to cover expansion to the Elk Valley and South Country for review.

Ms. Crane provided draft copies of Fernie Community Fund Terms of Reference for the Governance Committee. Grant Making Committee and Fund Development and Promotions Committee for review.

Directors discussed the policy(s) content in considerable detail and President Eburne will forward their comments/concerns to Ms. Crane for consideration and/or inclusion.

GRANTS

Questions concerning administrative fees charged on interest income have been resolved. Past fees charged are consistent with our Policy.

The Granting Committee will proceed with the granting process.

Directors suggested that the existing endowment agreement format be changed. Wording needs to be concise and less ambiguous with little or no room for interpretation. The agreement re-write needs to be undertaken immediately and provided to the Board for their approval as soon as possible.

NOMINATIONS

President Eburne will propose several members of the community to act as directors for consideration and approval at the Annual General meeting.

DONOR STEWARDSHIP

President Eburne would like Foundation Directors to consider 'adopting' one (or more) Donors in order to develop and maintain a one on one relationship. This practice might encourage greater interest from donors and potentially encourage them to increase the amount of their endowment.

Report to the Cranbrook and District Community Foundation board of directors June 6, 2016

Committee: CDCF Grant-Making Committee Chairperson: David Struthers

Date of last meeting: June 6, 2016 Date of next meeting: not set

 Members of the Grant-Making committee individually reviewed and scored 10 applications received from 10 different organizations. Total funds requested equaled \$32,544 from project budgets totaling \$754,591.

• The Grant-Making committee met on June 6, 2016 to review the applications and determine the allocation of endowment grants. A total of \$4,727.17 was available for granting from the various CDCF endowment funds; a total of \$4,011.15 is recommended for allocation. The attached table provides a summary of the projects the committee recommends for the 2016 granting cycle and the funds from which the grants are to be allocated. The committee presents the following motion to the CDCF board for consideration:

That the Cranbrook and District Community Foundation approve the following grants for 2016 as per the recommendations of the Grant-Making Committee:

- \$1,000.00 to the Cranbrook Boys and Girls Club for their Youth Impact Biking Club;
- \$1,156.15 to the Community Connections Society of Southeast BC, for the Better at Home Social Connections program;
- \$500.00 to Big Brothers Big Sisters of Cranbrook for their Reaching Out program; and
- \$1,355.00 to Summit Community Services Society for the Men's Support Program.

Applications were received which identified either the **Arts, Culture and Heritage** or the **Environment** field of interest. However, the committee did not feel these applications were closely aligned with the purpose of the available funds and therefore decided to carry-forward the amounts in the Winter Games fund for Arts & Culture and Environmental Endowment Fund.

The committee provided suggestions for further refinement of the grant application form and application review/scoring process. These suggestions will be incorporated into the 2017 granting process.

A big thanks to Riley for doing an initial review of the applications and preparing the grant packages for committee members, Jody Jacob and Livia Lara for helping prepare the endowment fund financial summary, and the Grant-Making committee members (Diana J Scott, Marion Eunson, Michele Bates, Devin Solberg and James Letcher) for their participation and thoughtful deliberations as committee members.

Executive Director Report – June 14, 2016

Anonymous Donor Funding Request

- Executive director requested the donor contribution limits be adjusted to 60% in year one, 55% in year two and 50% in year three. Donor Consultant out of office until week of June 13, 2016 approval of request pending.
- Letter of request for \$25,000 in matching funding for Fernie Community Fund to be submitted to consultant upon their return. We have met all requirements for matching funds through anonymous donor.

Annual General Meeting

- Scheduled date of June 14, rescheduled for Annual General Meeting
- An AGM must be held within 15 months of the previous AGM for all charities registered under the Canada Not-For-Profit Corporations Act. It is my recommendation that CDCF hold their meeting not later September 2016.

Nominations to the CDCF Board of Directors

- New nominations package reviewed. It is a useful tool for board and staff
- Scheduled meeting June 16 with Jennifer Krotz

Audit and Charitable Return

- Extensive work with BDO for audit preparation.
- BDO to prepare T3010 (charity information return) for June 30, 2016 deadline.
- Both the audit and charitable return require the oversight of a treasurer. It is recommended that CDCF board of directors establish an interim director to oversee the responsibilities of the treasurer until one is appointed at the 2016 AGM
- Recommendation that staff receive QuickBooks training through BDO

- Notifications to all applicants to be distributed after board approval of Grant Making Committee recommendations.

Columbia Basin Trust
