Utilities Billing and Payment Schedule

Discussion:

Reserves: Amount of money to be put into reserves to be determined when year- end has been completed.

Cross over connection: Check valve, one required for the entrance to Anaconda. Design required, power, highway easement. Priority to prevent cross-contamination. Work on getting an easement. Capital project.

Water:

Comprehensive MPA Tests on the water: On list to be done. Sampling of the creek and wells. Year long test. RFP City pays for the test. Multiple Particulate Analysis. Interior Health requirement: \$26,000 for three wells, will need an additional.

Re-develop Well 4: On list to be done. \$18,000. Request for proposal.

Well 5: Companies are working on fixing the problem – should be no cost to the City.

Generator: Has been installed and is in the process of the start- up tests.

Sewer:

Pumps for Lift Station 1: Money owed by residents must be paid in order to spend any more money this year on needed pumps. Approximately \$11,000 each. Should be ordering in 2017 budget.

Lift Station 2: Electrical is ready. Waiting for pumps to go in. Lift Station 2 under the Clean Water Waste Water Grant. Mechanical bar screens and generator still to be determined if we have the finances under the grant.

Lift Station 3: Will be need to upgraded.

Garbage:

- Garbage truck or put a new box on the garbage truck.

Option for RDKB picking up garbage: To stay with Council's original decision to look after our own garbage.

Conclusion:

Utility Increase to be 2% re: Utilities Billing and Payment Schedule Bylaw 913. Commercial garbage will remain the same at \$2.00 per bag.
