



Caring For Your Cut Tree



If temperatures are below -6°C , sheared, cultured trees MUST be protected when being transported. The trees should not freeze for best results.

Unbundle your tree and bang the stump on a hard surface a number of times to dislodge the previous years' brown needles.

Make a fresh cut of 2-4 cm off the butt of the tree and place into water within 10-15 minutes.

Fill the water reservoir with HOT water for the first time only. Refill the reservoir, using warm water.

Never let the reservoir run dry, because the tree will not be able to drink, even if the reservoir is refilled. A fresh cut will be needed.

Place your tree well away from heating elements & vents or cover them to protect your tree.

Do not keep your tree indoors once the needles start to become dry because it is a potential fire hazard.

Dispose of your tree in an environmentally responsible way by taking it to be chipped.
